- 1. Host fees- \$50 per team.
- 2. Reimburse the cost of awards provided by the state organization.
 - a. Championship Flags for each age group in Baseball and/or each age group in Softball
 - b. Championship and Runners Up Rings
 - c. Championship T-shirts for players and coaches in each age group.
- 3. Playing fields and score keeping meeting DYB specifications.
 - a. Fields relined between games.
 - b. PA system on each field.
 - c. At least two people on each field to keep the official scorebook, pitch count, scoreboard and announce over PA system.
 - d. If score keepers are not in an enclosed score box, the work area must be marked off with some type of boundary from spectators.

4. Gate Receipts

- a. All gate receipts remain with the host except for donations collected for the scholarship fund.
- b. State Board will set maximum fees host may charge per day and for tournament passes.
- c. Host will charge \$1 in addition to the gate fee on the first two days of the tournament with proceeds going to the scholarship fund.

5. Umpires

- a. Host must provide umpires and pay them a rate commensurable to the area.
- b. Tournament director has the authority to remove an umpire from the rotation if deemed necessary.
- c. Umpires must attend a pretournament meeting with the tournament director at a time set by the tournament director.

6. Miscellaneous

- a. Home run balls must be retrieved for presentation to the player at the end of the game by the tournament director.
- b. Provide water and soft drinks to tournament officials.
- c. Provide a meal to tournament officials on site at mealtimes. This can be provided from the concession stand or other sources.
- d. Brackets must be posted in a location where they are visible for spectators and updated as games are completed.
