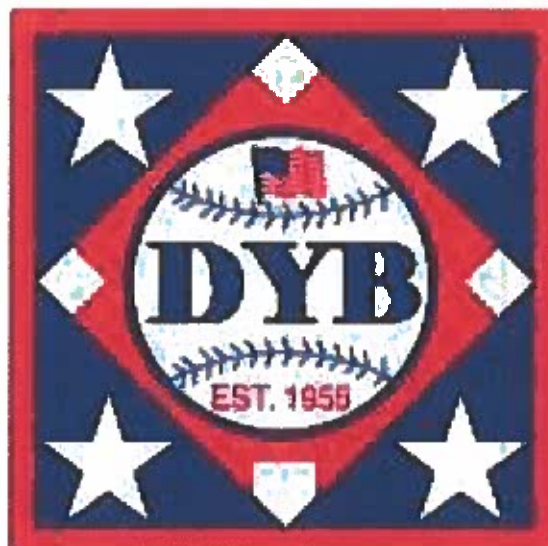

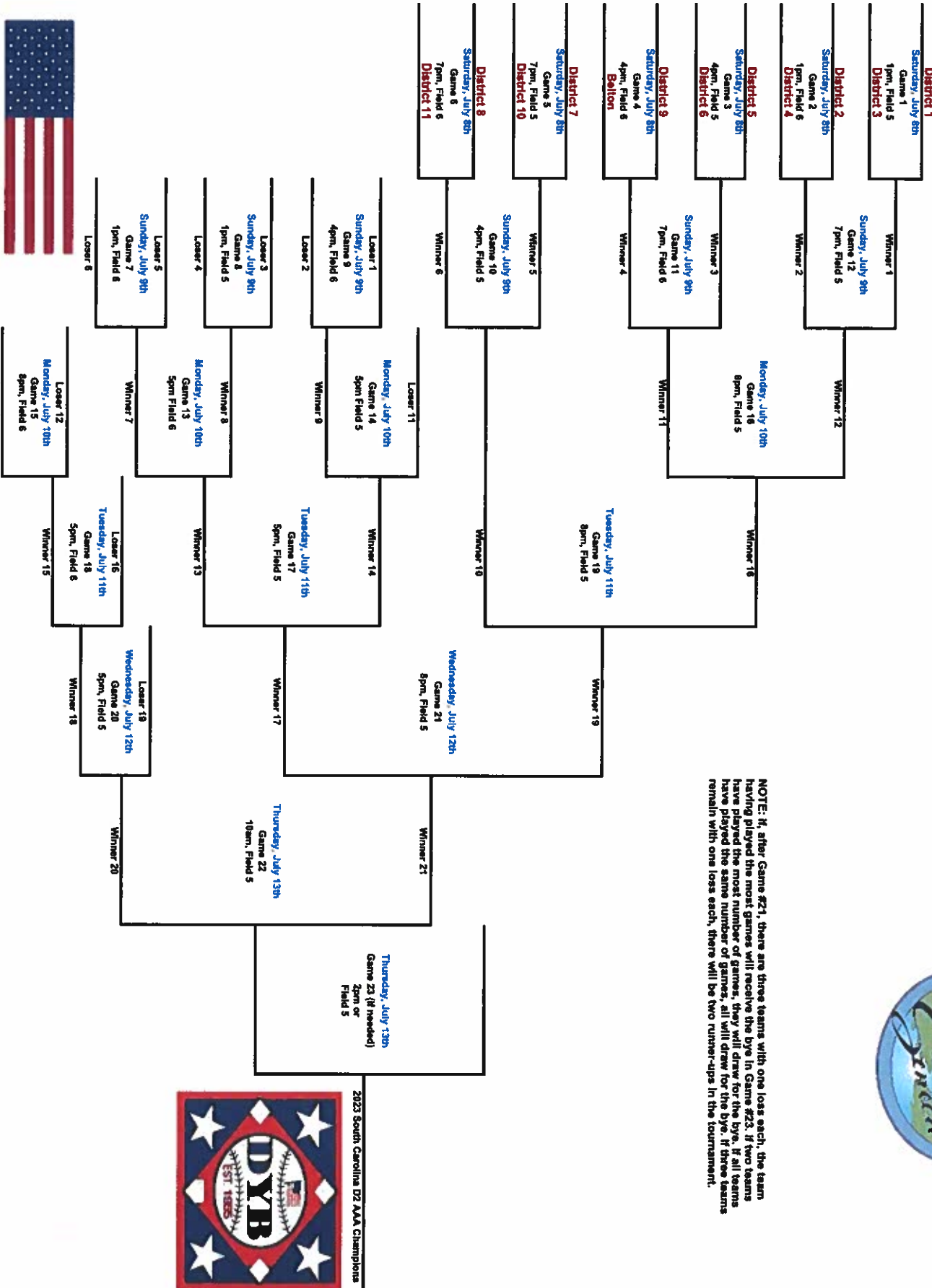

NOTE: If, after Game #21, there are three teams with one loss each, the team having played the most games will receive the bye in Game #23. If two teams have played the most number of games, they will draw for the bye. If all teams have played the same number of games, all will draw for the bye. If three teams remain with one loss each, there will be two runner-ups in the tournament.
