## When:

- Local competitions are held from November-July 31<sup>st</sup> ---WINNERS --> Team Championship competitions are held August-October ---WINNERS --> The National Finals are held post MLB's World Series 2 in the Game 1 & 2's Stadium.
- Local and Team Championship Winners are not guaranteed to move on to next level. Winners are put into a pool and Top Performing Winners are selected to compete at the next level.

<u>Why:</u> Pitch, Hit & Run your way through your local competition and earn a chance to compete at one of PHR's Team Championship sites held within Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball's Stadiums spread across the US.
