




Brain Injury Awareness Month provides an important opportunity to bring attention to the prevention of traumatic brain injury (TBI) and to promote strategies to improve the quality of life for persons living with TBI and their families. TBIs affect millions of people in the U.S each year.

A concussion is a type of TBI caused by a bump, blow or jolt to the head or by a hit to the body that causes the head to move back quickly back and forth. Help your child's team create a culture of safety. Work with the coach to teach ways to lower the chances of sustaining a concussion. Tell your child to report any concussion symptoms to you and their coach right away. Be sure to remind them that it's better to miss one game than the whole season!

DYB Spotlight – Matthew N. Goyak



Matt Goyak was one of the four original incorporators of DYB, Inc. and served as the President of the organization from 1955-2005. Matt enlisted in the United States Navy during World War II and served abord the battleship USS Alabama. After the war, he played semi-pro baseball in the Pirate's organization throughout the south, eventually settling in Georgetown, SC. After his baseball career ended, he was hired by the City of Georgetown as the city's first Recreation Director. He retired as the Recreation Director of Georgetown County in 1982 after 35 years of service. Matt received the "Order of the Palmetto" award from SC Governor David Beasley in 1995 for his contributions to the State of South Carolina.

Matt passed away on February 9, 2015 at the age of 90.
